#### LOCAL ENROLMENT APPLICATIONS

Manly Vale Public School accepts applications for enrolment from local students (residing in our school's catchment area). An enrolment application can only be accepted if the proof of address confirms the child as living in our school's catchment area. Please note: Norfolk Island permanent residents and New Zealand citizens holding a current New Zealand citizen passport and residing in our school's drawing area may be admitted in the same manner as Australian permanent residents.

**An** application **for a local enrolment** can only be processed if parents or guardians can provide evidence of:

- proof of student's local address originals of different documents such as your council rates notice
  or residential lease and electricity bill, driver's license, statutory declaration (100 point address
  checks will be conducted at the time of enrolment. See table below.
- any family law or other relevant court orders (if applicable).
- a child's birth certificate or identity documents
- an immunisation history statement based on the Australian Childhood Immunisation Register (ACIR)

For children **already enrolled in a NSW public school** and residing locally we also require at least 100 points of proof of residence:

- proof of student's address originals of different documents such as council rates notice, residential lease or electricity / water / telephone account
- Details of previous school if applicable

#### **NON-LOCAL ENROLMENT APPLICATIONS**

In most instances our school will be unable to accept enrolment applications from students <u>residing</u> <u>outside the school's catchment area</u>. As a matter of process any enrolment application from an out of area student will be referred to <u>the student's local designated Public School</u>. A request for an out of area application may then be submitted for consideration by the non-local school's enrolment panel.

Please note: Most schools significantly restrict the number of "Non-Local Enrolments".

#### **NON-LOCAL ENROLMENT APPLICATIONS PROCESS**

- 1. Parents in the first instance are requested to make an application for enrolment at their designated local school (according to school catchment maps)
- 2. Parents may make an application for a Non-Local Enrolment for a school other than their local Public School based on the Department's enrolment policy guidelines for 'out of area' applications to be considered by the school's enrolment panel and according to the Department's policy and subject to selection criteria such as availability of appropriate staff and classroom accommodation.
- 3. **The criteria that may be considered** for seeking an "out of area' enrolment application could include factors such as:
  - proximity and access to the school
  - · siblings already enrolled at the school
  - · medical reasons
  - safety and supervision of the student before and after school
  - · availability of subjects or combinations of subjects
  - special interests and abilities
  - · compassionate circumstances
  - structure and organisation of the school
  - family law or other relevant court orders (if applicable).

Students on temporary visas may be enrolled in their local area school based on residential address within the school boundary or they may request enrolment in an out of area school. A request for an out of area school. A request for an out of area enrolment may be considered by a school's enrolment panel, according to the Department's policy and subject to selection criteria such as availability of appropriate staff and classroom accommodation.

Students must hold a current valid visa for temporary residence in Australia and must meet the specific travel, entry and residency conditions determined by the Australian Department of Immigration & Citizenship (DIAC). Enrolment in the New South Wales government school is generally accepted for the length of the visa subject to policy and the terms and conditions of admission.

Temporary resident **students are not to be admitted** by a New South Wales government school **without an Authority to Enrol** issued by the Temporary Residents Program.
