Bushfire season

We are now in the Bushfire season. Today we practiced our evacuation drill for our "Early Release procedures." We will be evacuating the school if the "Hazards near me" app shows "Watch and Alert" or if the Rural Bushfire Service tells us to go. The early release procedures have been put in place as a precaution as we have no safe place to evacuate to if there is a bushfire threat nearby. The Early release [procedures give us the opportunity to send the students home prior to an immediate threat. Evacuation drills do end up at Millers reserve otherwise, but these will only be used in absolute emergencies. All parents have given emergency contacts if they are not able to collect their children when this alert goes out.
