Terms & Conditions



Hours of Operation

Vacation Care hours - 7:00am to 6:00pm

Pick up after 6:00pm incurs a late fee of \$15 per every 15mins or part thereof. Normal delivery and collection procedures apply.

Excursion Day Timing & Transport

Children will leave the centre for excursions at 9:30am and return by 3:30pm unless otherwise stated, and will travel on hired coaches. On an excursion day, please arrive no later 1 hour before the scheduled departure.

What to Bring & Wear/Food Available

Children should bring:

- morning tea & lunch
- a sun hat & a raincoat
- a refillable pop-top drink bottle

Children must wear a hat, a top that covers shoulders, sun cream and enclosed shoes.

No responsibility will be accepted for children's property brought to Vacation Care.

Breakfast is available between 7:00am - 8:00am. Afternoon tea is provided.

In line with Koolkuna's Policy we aim to be a **nut free zone**.

Excursion Information

Children may bring spending money on excursion days if desired. However, it is at the discretion of the staff whether children will be allowed to purchase items at each venue on the day. During the day, the children may go on mini walking excursions within the local area. The children often wade at the beach, not above their knees.

Waivers

For some excursions families will be required to complete a waiver form.

Risk Assessments and Staff Ratios

Risk assessments for each activity & venue are available at the service. Staff to child ratio is:

- Onsite = 1:15
- Offsite (excursion) = 1:8
- Excursions involving water e.g. swimming = 1:5

Booking and Payment Policy

Booking forms will not be accepted & confirmed unless a current Enrolment Form and a current Debitsuccess Form are held on file. Direct debits are processed fortnightly for bookings 2 weeks in advance.

Cancellation Policy

Changes or cancellations will be accepted until 2 weeks prior to your booking. Thereafter no changes or cancellations can be accepted without a Medical Certificate.

Changes to Planned Program

There may be occasions where the planned program must be changed due to weather conditions or the illness of an instructor. Families will be notified. One of the following will substitute the planned program:

- Hoyts (Warringah Mall)
- AMF Bowling (Dee Why)
- Laster Tag (Entertianment Quarter)

Cost Breakdown

Base Day rate = \$60 per student; plus

Variable Daily Activity cost eg. \$60 + \$15 = \$75

An Administration Fee of \$33 is payable by all families on an annual basis at the time of enrolment.
